


- *The* key issue on the doorstep – affects us all
- The sector *most* impacted by changes in legislation post-Brexit
- Central to some of the biggest challenges we face – climate change; food, energy + water security
- The fundamental basis for strong economy, society + well-being – now and for future generations




Future Budget Pressures to 19-20 (£m) Pwysau cyllidebol ychwanegol hyd 2019-20 (£m)

Papur Llywodraeth Cymru: cydweithio'n rhanbarthol



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- Retain the 22 LAs but...
- ...‘mandatory and systemic regional working’
- Two regional footprints proposed:
 - city regions covering strategic transport, land-use planning and economic development and
 - health board areas for services such as education improvement, social services and public protection
- Cadw'r 22 awdurdod lleol ond...
- ...‘cydweithio'n rhanbarthol yn ôl trefn statudol’
- mae dwy drefn wedi'u cynnig:
 - ffiniau rhanbarthau dinasol ar gyfer cludiant strategol, cynllunio ar gyfer defnyddio tir a datblygu'r economi
 - ffiniau byrddau iechyd ar gyfer gwasanaethau megis gwella addysg, diogelu'r cyhoedd a gofal cymdeithasol

The case for regional working

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The case against regional working

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| <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Moves decision making further from communities• Risk of multiple arrangements, each with own bureaucracy• Political differences between LAs in a region• Costs and benefits may be unevenly spread• Risk of being locked into inflexible arrangements• Harmonisation issues (labour force, ICT) | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Symud prosesau penderfynu o'r cymunedau• Perygl o ddyblygu trefniadau a gwaith papur• Gwahaniaethau gwleidyddol ymhllith awdurdodau rhanbarth• Costau a buddion anghyson ymhllith ardaloedd• Perygl o fod yn gaeth i drefniadau anhyblyg• Anawsterau cysoni (gweithlu, TGCh ac ati) |

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Brexit implications

Goblygiadau gadael Undeb Ewrop



- c5,000 EU laws over 40 yrs on environmental and rural matters
- What could happen?:
 - Little change (rules still apply under 'soft Brexit')
 - UK decides to retain laws and uphold standards
 - New, 'home grown' laws and policies – greening or deregulation?
- Environment is a devolved matter – implications?
- Highly significant to LAs, who have to implement
- Lesley Griffiths roundtable – stakeholder involvement
- Tua 5,000 o ddeddfau Undeb Ewrop am faterion amgylcheddol a gwledig dros 40 mlynedd
- Yr hyn allai ddigwydd:
 - heb newid llawer (yr un rheolau ar waith)
 - penderfynu cadw'r deddfau a'r safonau
 - llunio deddfau a pholisiau newydd – rhagor neu lai?

 - Wildlife
